Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6 (BSB)

God, I pray today that _____ will trust You with all her heart even when she doesn't understand. God direct her path as she leans on You!

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

God, I ask today that when _____ begins to worry, You will remind her about this verse. With prayer and thanksgiving allow her to turn her worries over to You in exchange for Your peace.

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. Psalms 139: 13-14 (NIV)

And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man. Luke 2:52 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ grows in these same ways, just like Jesus. Help her grow mentally (wisdom), physically (stature), spiritually and emotionally (In favor with God and man).

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as though you were working for the Lord and not for people. Col 3:23 (GNT)

God, I pray _____ works with all her heart for You. Remind her that her job is to please You, not others.

Your Word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path. Psalm 119:105 (NLT)

God, I pray _____ dives daily into Your Word. Please light the path You have for her and guide her feet.

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ will be strong and courageous. Not in her own strength, but only as she depends on You. Help her remember You will be with her wherever she goes.

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. Philippians 1:6 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ confidently knows that You will never give up on her. You began a good work in her and promise to carry it on to completion until Jesus comes again or she meets Him face to face.
