Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6 (BSB)

God, I pray today that _____ will trust You with all his heart even when he doesn't understand. God direct his path as he leans on You!

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

God, I ask today that when _____ begins to worry, You will remind him about this verse. With prayer and thanksgiving allow him to turn his worries over to You in exchange for Your peace.

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. Psalms 139: 13-14 (NIV)

And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man. Luke 2:52 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ grows in these same ways, just like Jesus. Help him grow mentally (wisdom), physically (stature), spiritually and emotionally (In favor with God and man).

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as though you were working for the Lord and not for people. Col 3:23 (GNT)

God, I pray _____ works with all his heart for You. Remind him that his job is to please You, not others.

Your Word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path. Psalm 119:105 (NLT)

God, I pray _____ dives daily into Your Word. Please light the path You have for him and guide his feet.

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ will be strong and courageous. Not in his own strength, but only as he depends on You. Help him remember You will be with him wherever he goes.

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. Philippians 1:6 (NIV)

God, I pray _____ confidently knows that You will never give up on him. You began a good work in him and promise to carry it on to completion until Jesus comes again or he meets Him face to face.
